



## A Guide for Filming your Hanson Community Arts Video

### Filming Location:

If possible, we would like you to:

- Choose the brightest room in our home for recording
- Choose a room with soft furnishings (e.g. your living room or a bedroom)
- Make sure there is no bright light directly behind you (e.g a window)
- Try not to stand directly underneath ceiling lights.

### Filming Setup:

You will need **TWO** devices for recording your video - one device to play the recording of the piece ([click here to access the recording](#)), and one to record the video on. You **MUST USE HEADPHONES** to listen to the recording, this is so that we cannot hear the recording in the video. We recommend that you use a Mobile Phone for recording your video.

### Filming Device:

- Make sure your phone is filming in **LANDSCAPE** and your phone is on its side.
- Make sure you are in the centre of the video and not too far away.
- Make sure there is no background noise.
- If possible, put your device on a stand instead of holding it, so that the video is stable and not moving around.

### Filming:

It's important that you clap **PRECISELY** when the recording tells you to. This is crucial to making sure all the videos are in sync when it comes to editing. It will help if you practice playing to the recording including the clap.

- Make sure you are listening to the recording through headphones. It is best to have one headphone in and one out so you can still hear yourself play.
- Make sure you listen back to the recording afterwards to ensure the audio is okay.
